1. Home for the Orphan children: By the grace of God, December 4th 2010, we opened a new home for orphan children, housing eight boys between the ages of 6 and 8. By now, we have added two more boys making it ten orphan boys who do not have both the parents. Some of their parents died in auto accidents and some died of illness such as HIV/AIDS. Some were living with their grandparents and some with their aunts and uncles. Many of them were not attending a school and their guardians are unable to take care of them. God has provided us with the finances to rent this excellent housing facility, we are praying about taking five more orphan boys into this home. We are trusting in God to open another orphan home in the city of Hyderabad, we ask for your continued prayers for suitable housing, dedicated house parents and finances to make this dream a reality.

2. Sewing project for poor women: In mid December 2010 we began sewing classes for thirty women in one of our churches. We started this training with 10 new sewing machines. Some of these women are widows who lost their husbands to HIV/AIDS. Others are poor women with no means of income. After they complete three months of training the first ten women will receive the new sewing machines. We hope to give 20 more machines to the remaining twenty women in the near future! We plan to train many more poor women and provide them with the means to generate income. This is a great opportunity for them to break free from poverty and develop financial independence.
